Decamp with the whole gang to these whip-smart hotel villas

BORGIO EGNAZIA, PUGLIA, ITALY

'Buongiorno bambini!' cries the concierge on arrival at this magnificent masseria, set among olive groves in the rugged Puglian countryside. Italians famously love children – not just their own but yours too – and the set-up at this hotel is ideal for families who want to be entertained without compromising on style. The vibe is incredibly glamorous and wonderfully chic. Check into Il Borgo, a mini village of bougainvillea-clad townhouses that are away from the hub of the main hotel. But there are also top-notch villas with private pools, cinema rooms and gardens. Everyone still congregates around the family pool, which is laid out to give parents sun-lounger time and children a rowdy ruck-about in the Trullalleri kids' club. The fun culminates in the nightly baby disco, a dance-off to Europop in the playground, handily situated near a rooftop cocktail bar so you can slink away for an hour.

INSIDER TIP Eat at Mia Cucina trattoria, where kids can make new friends at the communal tables.
